The Nottinghamshire Birdwatchers, formerly known as the Trent Valley Birdwatchers, was formed in 1935 and is the recognized body for the compilation of ornithological records within the County. It is affiliated to the BTO, the RSPB, Wildfowl and Wetlands Trust and the Nottinghamshire Wildlife Trust.

The Society offers the following facilities to members:---

- Local bird news phone line, charged at local rates.
- A Monthly newsletter of local bird watching news.
- An Annual Bird Report.
- Organized Field Trips to a variety of locations throughout the UK.
- Indoor meetings, slide shows and informal society functions.
- Opportunities to participate in organized fieldwork.

We are keen to encourage members to participate in all the activities of the society and specifically to receive your own records of bird sightings in the County for inclusion in the news letter and Annual Report.

Cost of membership for one calendar year is **£14 for ADULTS** and **£7 for JUNIORS (under 16)**.

FAMILY MEMBERSHIP is also £14 per year but note that only one newsletter and one Annual Report will be issued to the family address.
